
WYNDHAM DEERFIELD BEACH WEDDINGS FAQs

Do I need a permit for beach ceremony?

The beach immediately in front of the resort is owned by the resort, so no city permit is required. There is a \$750 beach ceremony fee which includes white folding chairs. This fee does not include decor items, No power is available at the beach. We have a list of preferred vendors that are wonderful resources for decor items and battery powered sound systems.

What times can we host a beach ceremony?

In respect to the other guests that enjoy our beach, and so that you have the best possible experience, we limit beach ceremonies to prior to 9:30am and one hour prior to sunset. During special events and holidays, we do not host beach ceremonies. These include, but are not limited to, President's Day weekend, Memorial Day weekend, the 4th of July, New Year's Eve & New Year's Day.

What other restrictions apply to a beach ceremony?

Rice, bird seed and other items may not be thrown during a beach ceremony. All amplified sound cannot be overly loud. All chair and decor items must be removed immediately after the ceremony

When must the decision be made to move an outdoor event inside?

Two hours prior to the start of your function a decision must be made in regards to moving an event due to weather. This decision will be made with the guest, hotel banquet manager and catering manager.

Other than the beach, what outdoor ceremony options are there?

The City of Deerfield Beach offers rental of their Observation Deck at the International Fishing Pier complex. This deck sits above the beach on the second level of the complex offering vast views of the ocean and pier. It is fully accessible with stairs and an elevator. It is rented in four hour increments. The Observation Deck does require a permit from the City of Deerfield Beach.

Can we do a beach ceremony without a reception?

A beach wedding ceremony must be accompanied by a reception in our ballroom if over 25 people or in one of our onsite restaurants if under 25 people.

Can I take pictures the International Fishing Pier?

The historic Deerfield Beach International Fishing Pier, the longest on the Atlantic coast, is operated by the City of Deerfield Beach. There is a fee of \$1 per person to enter the pier. Photography is welcome but no area can be blocked off specifically for photos.

What are the options for parking for my guests?

Valet and self parking is available at the resort. Self parking for your event is \$10 per car and valet parking is \$15.

For overnight guests, self parking is \$14 per car per night and valet is \$19 per car per night.
